In a well-functioning landscape, rainfall enters or runs off the ground surface without eroding the soil. In this activity, David Tongway AM, a member of FOG and a recognised expert in the field, will explain how to analyse landscape function on a slope.

● ParkCare at the Pinnacle - Achievements & Challenges

Join fotpin's resident webmeister and record keeper Warren Bond as he points out the many changes at the reserve since the tree plantings and other work in the 1990s by fotpin's predecessor, the Pinnacle Environment Group. This walk will visit vantage points where photos were taken in 1991 to observe the impacts of that early work. We'll also visit recent plantings at the Reserve to assess their progress and explain the thinking behind them. We'll look at ongoing issues with weeds, including areas where we've made progress, and also look at erosion and some of the other challenges we currently face.
